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Results Framework

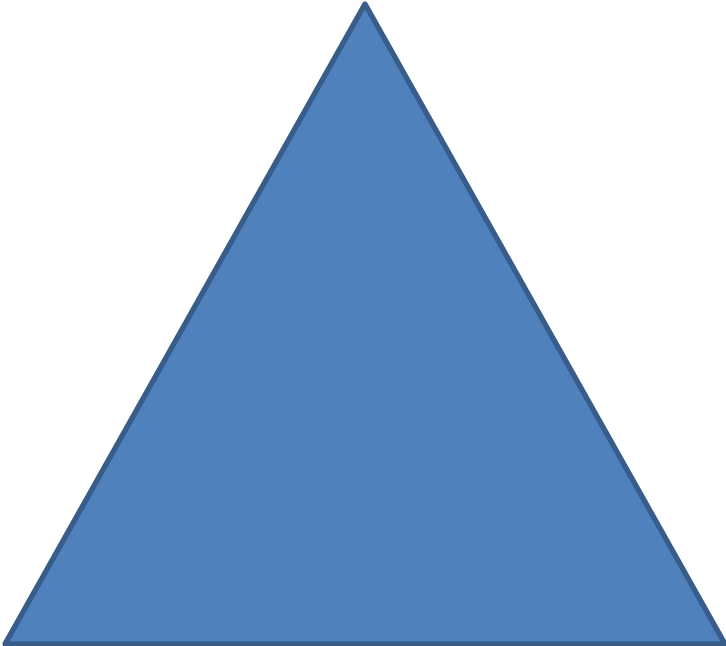
- Approach is Results Based and Results are point of interaction in M&E design and implementation. Hence preference of Results Frameworks to Log frames.
- At the programme level a Tilitonse results framework: defining the programme Impact, Outcome and Outputs, indicators risks and assumptions.
- At Grantee level, individual funded projects ***must develop*** their own results frameworks that are expected to make a contribution to the achievement of the overall results particularly at output level.

Result Framework- content

- **Summary of the project intervention** as is presented in the project proposal- Section 2.2 of the application form.
- **Thematic Call Results** - origin of the project results are the summaries on LG, Mining and Access to Information (Issues and what can be done).
- **But Highlight** Specific change in governance that is expected to occur as a result of the project- Results should relate to four Tilitonse Outputs.
- **Project Outputs:** Direct Results that provides conditions necessary for the achievement of the outcome. Outputs indicate results areas that if achieved will bring about change at the purpose level and **NOT** outputs as completed activities.
- Logical causal linkage between the Goal, Purpose statement, outputs, indicators, Baseline, Targets & list of activities under each output

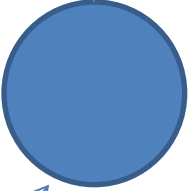

Our Experiences- Don'ts

- Lack of clarity on results to be achieved & poor definition of results- copy and pasting.
- Level of ambition unrealistic- writing to impress and little focus on risks and assumptions.
- Weak internal logic- CSO still primarily driven to implement activities than results.
- Mismatch between problem identified and Results
- Too many indicators and in some cases irrelevant

Sustainability

- Plans and mechanism that the interventions and results will continue after the direct financial support from Tilitonse-external support.
- In built design that empowers people rather than CSO doing things for the people.
- Potential that the project can be replicated and be scaled up
